EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 029

ESTABLISHING THE ARMM CRISIS MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, the Regional Government is mandated to give priority to the maintenance and preservation of law and order for the establishment of peace and the protection of life, liberty, and property of the people in the autonomous region, in consonance with the provisions of the Constitution and the Organic Act;

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 82, series of 2012 issued by the President established the national and local crisis management organizations and provided a practical guide therefor;

WHEREAS, the peace and order situation in the region has been threatened by the presence of armed groups, rebels and extremists which prompts the Regional Government to establish a Crisis Management Committee;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MUJIV S. HATAMAN, Regional Governor of the Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order:

SECTION 1. There is hereby established an ARMM Crisis Management Committee that shall serve as the policy and decision-making body in managing human-induced crises at the regional level.

SECTION 2. The Committee shall have the following composition:

SECTION 3. The ARMM Crisis Management Committee shall be responsible for determining the appropriate level of crisis response based on continuous and thorough assessment of the situation. The Committee shall assume authority, effectively carry out functions, and take on responsibilities and accountabilities. Specifically, that:

- a. The Regional Secretary of the Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG) shall be the Cabinet-Officer Primarily Responsible for Public Safety, Security, Emerging and Current Threats to Peace and

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Order, such as civil disturbances, violent labor strikes, riots, anarchy and disorderly mass demonstrations.

- b. The Regional Secretary of the Department of Health (DOH) shall be the Cabinet-Officer Primarily Responsible for emerging and current threats to public health, and shall be the Point Person for Medical Services.
- c. The Regional Secretary of the Department of Trade and Industry (DTI) shall be the Cabinet-Officer Primarily Responsible for emerging and current threats to the economy.
- d. The Regional Secretary of the Department of Public Works & Highways (DPWH) shall be the Point Person for Logistics.
- e. The Regional Secretary of the Department Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) and ARMM Humanitarian Emergency Action Response Team (HEART) shall be the Point Person for Community Relations, Social Services, Response and Relief.
- f. The Executive Director of the Regional Planning and Development Office (RPDO) shall be the Point Person for Rehabilitation.

SECTION 4. The **ARMM Crisis Management Committee** shall create and organize an Incident Command System, and designate an Incident Commander who shall review existing intra- and inter-agency/department contingency plans for suitability and develop a Crisis Action Plan when no contingency plan exists.

SECTION 5. If any provision of this Executive Order is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the other provisions not affected thereby shall remain valid and subsisting.

SECTION 6. All regional orders, rules and regulations inconsistent with this Executive Order are hereby repealed, amended, or modified accordingly.

SECTION 7. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately after the completion of its publication in the Official Gazette or in a newspaper of regional circulation.
